How many animals can you find?

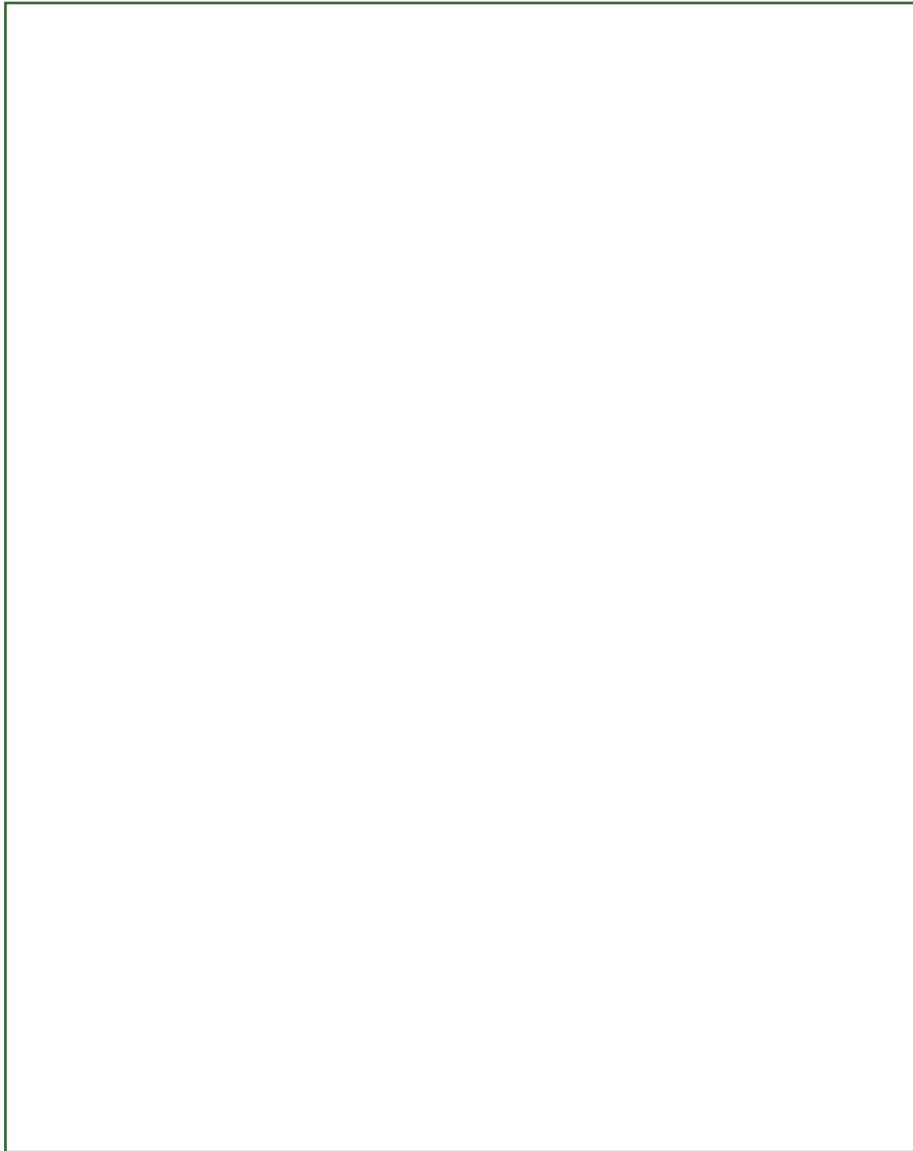
Get outside and see how many animals you can find.
